A PARISH PLAN FOR ROWLANDS CASTLE

Dear Resident

In 2000 a Village Design Statement (VDS) was prepared by a group of volunteers sponsored by the Parish Council and the Rowlands Castle Association. The VDS encompassed the parish of Rowlands Castle - which includes Finchdean, Idsworth and the outlying farms and dwellings - and described those parish qualities which were especially valued by its residents. It was subsequently 'adopted' by East Hampshire District Council, to provide criteria for assessing planning applications. As the VDS will cease to apply after 2009, a wider ranging document called a 'Parish Plan' is now proposed by National and Local Government, to consider those aspects of village life which are important to residents.

The Parish Council and Rowlands Castle Association are again supporting a group of volunteers who form a 'Steering Group' to supervise this new project. Following preliminary discussions with officers of Village societies and associations, the Steering Group now welcomes your views on life in the parish. It invites you and other members of your household, to respond to the attached questionnaire covering a range of issues that may also apply to other parishes, but are felt to have particular relevance to our parish.

The anonymity of all respondents will be respected. Similarly names will also be withheld of any individuals who identify themselves when asking to discuss specific points, or offering themselves as volunteers for identified projects or activities.

Why should I complete and return this Questionnaire?

- * As a valued resident of this parish, to find out what you think of life in the parish, what is important to you and what you want to remain the same.
- * To identify concerns that you might have, and improvements that you might want to make.

How will the answers be used?

The answers will be used to identify and make a case for improving those aspects of the Village that you like, and for seeking to address any concerns. Based on this information, actions may be initiated by Parish, District or County Councils, by other agencies working in the Village, or by new project groups set up to make a specific case and seek funding.

The Government considers the availability of systematic data from this survey as essential for justifying the allocation of public funds and any wider appeal for funding.

Will I see the survey results?

The consolidated results will be published in the RCA Magazine and meetings held to brief residents, officers of Village societies and associations, and the Parish Council.

How do I seek advice and find out more about the Ouestionnaire and Plan?

The Questionnaire contains two sections that you should complete as follows.


- The HOUSEHOLD SECTION. Only one person in the household should complete this question. It asks for some general information about your household, its location within the parish, your age and gender, and will help with analysis of the response.
- The **PERSONAL SECTION** contains a number of **Topic headings** with several questions under each topic. You may add comments at the end of each topic as you wish. For most questions you should tick $(\sqrt{})$ your choice but some questions require you to add a number to indicate your opinion. The instructions *in italics* at the start of each question will tell you which is required.

The **PERSONAL SECTION** should be completed by *each household member* aged eleven or over, as we want to hear all your views. We would like you to do this as follows.
